Forecast Discussion

An area of low pressure will move across northern Illinois and Indiana today with an associated cold front stretching back across portions of Illinois and Missouri. This frontal system will slowly push towards the area over the next 24-36 hours. Upper-level disturbances will move along this front and across the area today into the first part of Thursday. As a result, periods of shower and thunderstorm activity are likely across the area especially later this morning into this afternoon and evening. Additional scattered showers and thunderstorms will remain possible through Thursday afternoon when the front is expected to make it across the area. Warmer temperatures along with a slight chance of an isolated afternoon/evening thunderstorm are expected for late this week into the weekend. Another cold front is forecast to move across next Monday cooling temperatures somewhat.

Severe Weather Outlook

No Severe Weather is expected through early next week. Will continue to monitor and update severe weather outlook in future forecasts.
